

Three days' scientist farmers interface meeting and input distribution under TSP Programme by CAZRI, RRS, Pali Marwar

Scientist farmers interface meeting on 'Improved package of practices for crops, fruits and vegetables production' was organized in tribal village Gorla, Tehsil Bali Dist Pali (Raj) for three days during 1-3rd September, 2022. A total of 808 tribal farmers participated in the interface meeting. Shri. Pushpendra Singh Ranawat, MLA of Bali Tehsil was invited as chief guest. In the welcome note, Dr.A.K.Shukla, Head of the station welcomed the chief guest and tribal farmers and presented a brief note on activities undertaken in TSP programme. Dr. R.S. Mehta, Principal Scientist (Agronomy) and Nodal officer TSP, explained about the management of Kharif intercrops and advised the know-how of using power operated sprayer and storage bin. He also demonstrated safety precautions and explained the know-how of using sprayer. In the chief guest note, Shri. Pushpendra Singh Ranawat, MLA appreciated ICAR-CAZRI, RRS, Pali for the efforts taken under TSP programme for the upliftment of tribal farmers. Later on, Chief guest, Shri. Pushpendra Singh Ranawat, MLA and Dr.A.K.Shukla, Head and Dr.R.S.Mehta, Principal Scientist (Agronomy) and Nodal officer (TSP) initiated the input distribution of different farm implements to tribal farmers. Dr. Keerthika A, Scientist (Agroforestry) also discussed the various agroforestry practices followed in the region. Dr.Kamla KChoudhary, Scientist (Soil Science) provided technical knowledge on management of crops under saline condition. After the interface meeting, in the first day (1st september, 2022) capital items viz., Kudali, Sickle and Geti were distributed to 210 tribal farmers. In the second and third day (2nd and 3rd September, 2022) storage bin, power operated sprayer, Kudali and Sickle were distributed to 250 and 348 tribal farmers. Farmers were also advised to make efficient use of storage bin, power operated sprayer and other farm implements. Farmers were happy on receiving the different farm items. The meeting ended with vote of thanks by Dr. R. S. Mehta, Principal Scientist (Agronomy).
